

ALC COUNCIL NEWS

Greetings Atonement family!

I hope you are all doing well and finding some time to enjoy the outdoors this summer. During these uncertain times, your Church Council and Pastor Linda continue to closely monitor the status of COVID-19. While our next scheduled Council meeting was set for July 6th, we decided to meet earlier and hold our July council meeting this week (Monday, June 29th) to revisit our plans for Worship and continue discussion on "phasing-in" back to Worship indoors as our state continues with the ND Smart Restart.

After much discussion and consideration, the council elected to continue with Outdoor Drive-In Style Parking Lot Worship through the duration of the summer. While we had hoped to transition to a "backyard" outdoor Worship, there were many factors to consider and as a result we decided continued parking lot Worship is the best option going forward. I'll share our rationale:

- 1) We determined that continued front parking lot Worship allows for the greatest flexibility for congregation members to practice social distancing at their own comfort level. The option to stay in the vehicle, bring a lawn chair and sit outside or put a blanket on the grass are all options available.
- 2) With the unpredictability of ND weather, the parking lot Worship service is more "weather-proof" allowing us to return to our vehicles if the weather requires (e.g., rain, extreme heat).
- 3) The current Worship modality requires the least amount of volunteer effort on Sundays. As summer is extremely busy for many, it has been quite challenging to have enough people assist with the extra needs associated with the services. We are so grateful to all of you who have helped make the services so special. If you haven't had a chance to help, please let Pastor Linda know you're available!
- 4) We were also concerned about accessibility of the backyard and felt that the parking lot is the most inclusive to all congregational members and reduces worry about navigating the uneven terrain.

Virtual Worship will remain an option for those not able to attend the "Parking Lot" Services.

The final piece of news I'd like to share is that the Council voted on a "Target date" to return to indoor Worship. The Council voted that our first indoor Worship will be on September 13th. While we have selected this date and will work to achieve this goal; we also know that the status of the pandemic will largely influence our ability to do so and we may need to adjust to ensure safety for all. There is a great deal of planning and preparation that needs to occur prior to September 13th and we want to thank all who are helping with developing the plan, processes and procedures to safely return to Worship indoors.

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we all continue to navigate through this uncertainty and put our faith in God to see us through.
